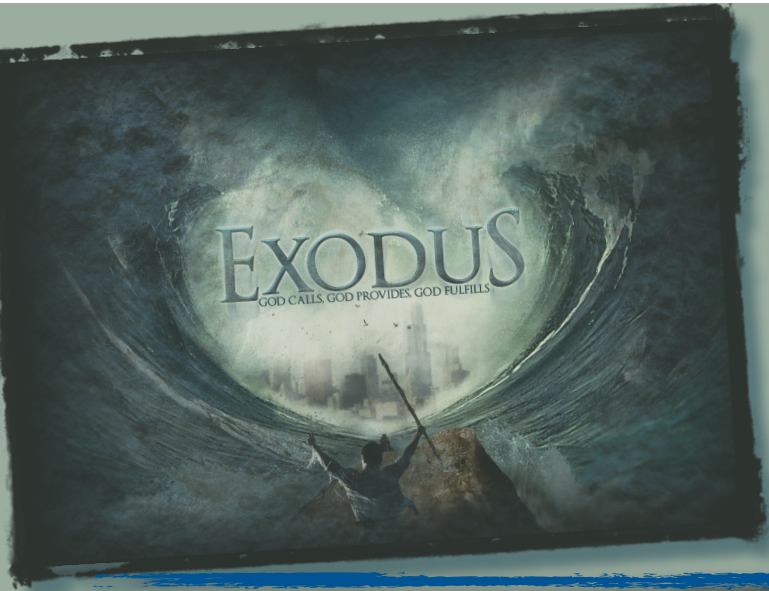

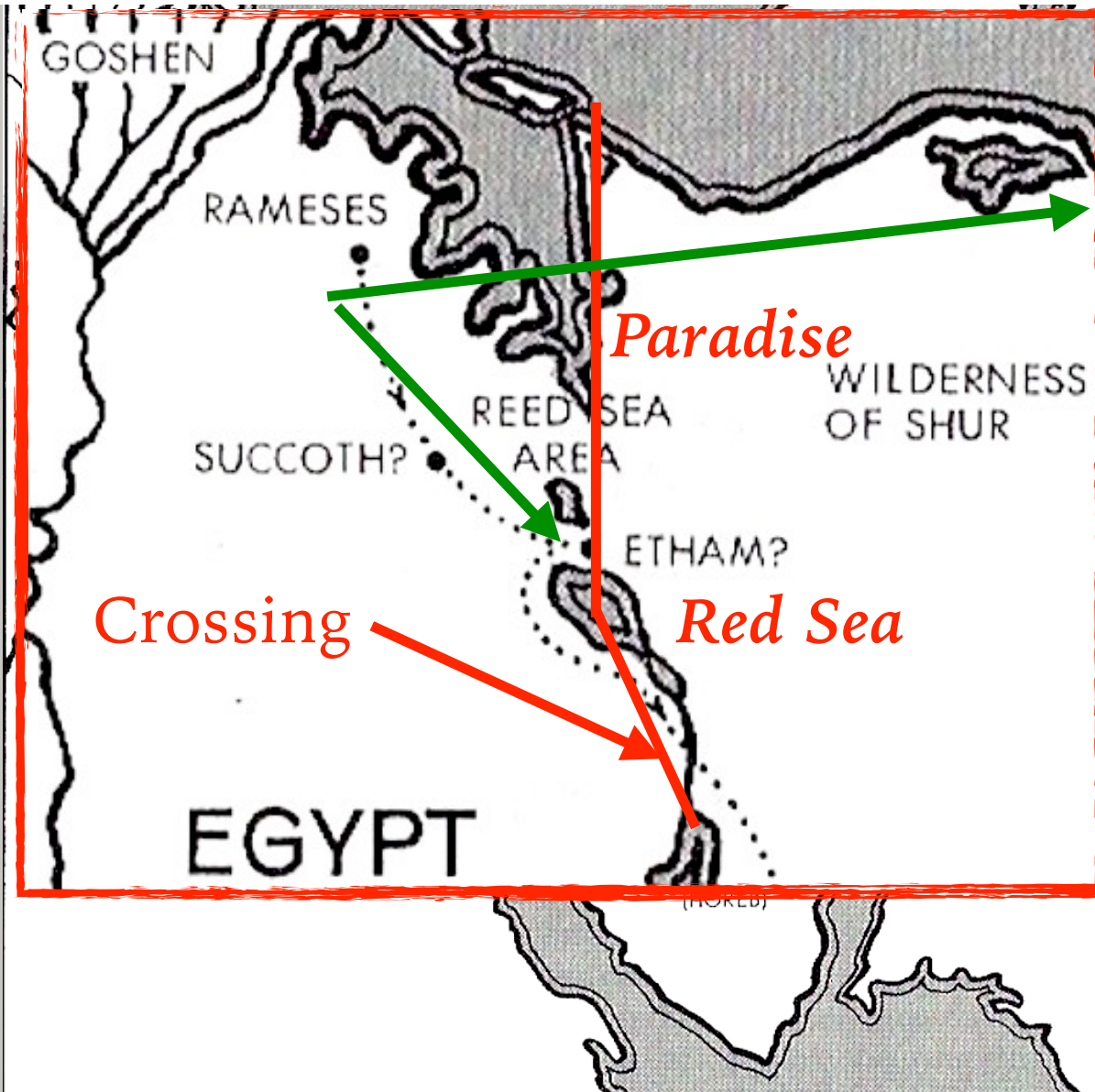

The Song Of Miriam

15:19-21 A Fitting Summary

Ex. 15:19-21 When Pharaoh's horses, chariots and horsemen went into the sea, the LORD brought the waters of the sea back over them, but the Israelites walked through the sea on dry ground ... Miriam sang to them

*“Sing to the LORD, for he is highly exalted.
The horse and its rider he has hurled into the sea.”*

Col. 1:13 For He rescued us from the domain of darkness,

Col. 1:14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
