Num 7 Participation Of The Tribes

7:1-9 Support for the Tribe of Levi

Gershonites: 2 wagons and 4 oxen

Merarites: 4 wagons and 8 oxen

All their work was to be done under the direction of Ithamar son of Aaron. But Moses gave no wagons or oxen to the **Kohathites** because the sacred objects they took care of had to be carried on their shoulders.

Num 7 Participation Of The Tribes

Num. 7:9-83 Dedicating Gifts to the Temple

1 silver bowl weighing 50 ounces

1 silver basin weighing 30 ounces

(both full of flour mixed with oil: **grain offering**)

1 gold dish weighing 4 ounces, full of **incense**

1 young bull, 1 ram, 1 one-yr-old lamb: **burnt offering**

1 goat: **sin offering**;

2 bulls, 5 rams, 5 goats, 5 one-yr-old lambs: **fellowship offering**

252 Animals

Num. 7:12 They presented their offerings in the following order:
1st, **Judah**—Nahshon son of Amminadab;
Num. 7:18 2nd, Issachar—Nethanel son of Zuar;
Num. 7:24 3rd, Zebulun—Eliab son of Helon;
Num. 7:30 4th, Reuben—Elizur son of Shedeur;
Num. 7:36 5th, Simeon—Shelumiel son of Zurishaddai;
Num. 7:42 6th, Gad—Eliasaph son of Deuel;
Num. 7:48 7th, **Ephraim**—Elishama son of Ammihud;
