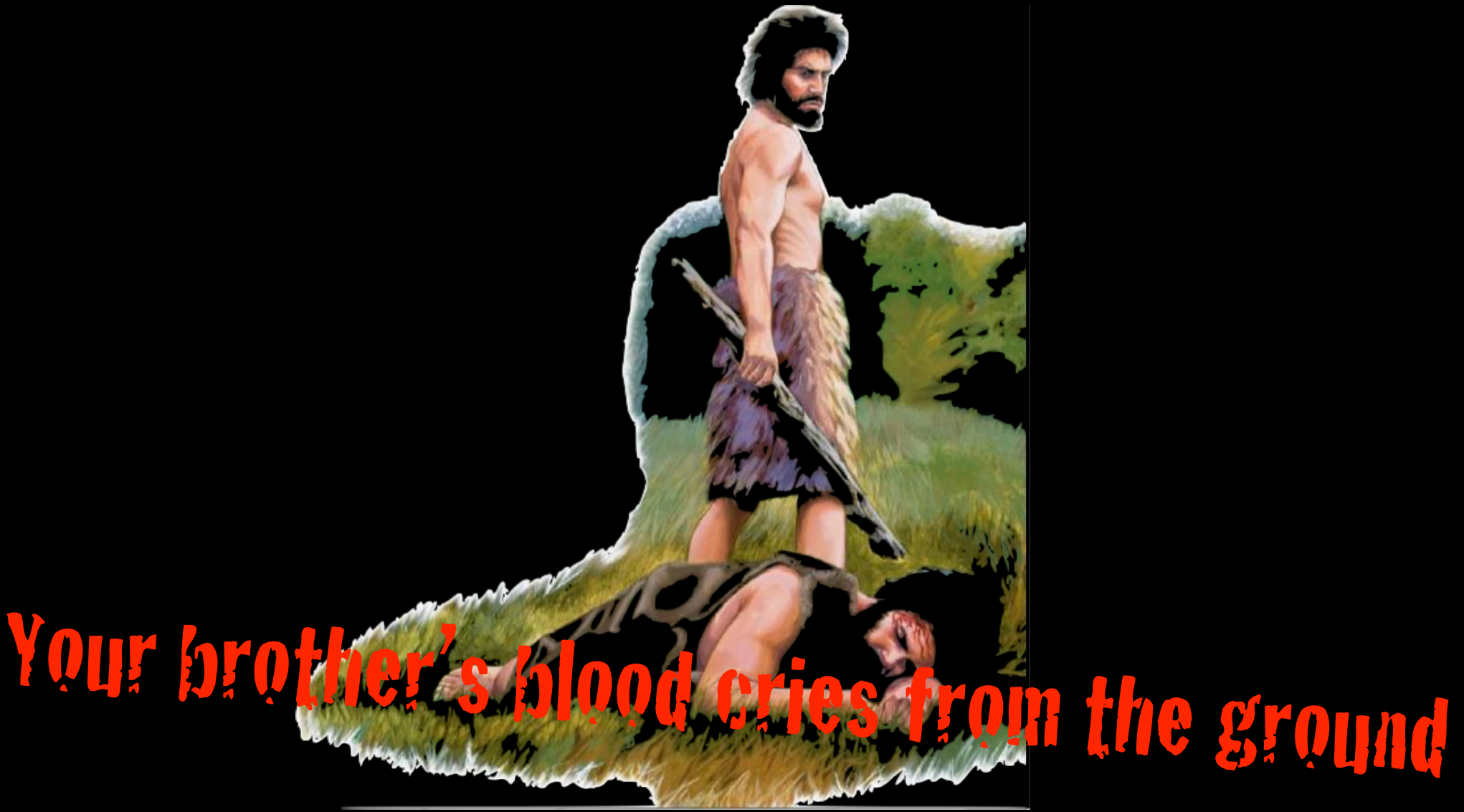

Hebrews 11:4 By faith Abel offered to God a **better sacrifice** than Cain, through which he **obtained the testimony** that he was **righteous**, **God testifying** about his gifts, and through faith, though he is dead, **He still speaks**

Hebrews 11:5 By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death; AND HE WAS NOT FOUND BECAUSE GOD TOOK HIM UP; for **he obtained the witness** that before his being taken up he was **pleasing to God**.

Two men of Faith: One dies, the other lives...
But both are *Alive!*

1John 3:11-15 ... we should love one another;
not *be* like Cain, being of the evil one, and who killed his brother.
And for what reason? Because his deeds were evil, and his
brother's were righteous.

Do not marvel, brethren, if the world hates you.

He who does not love abides in death.

Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer

and you know that no murderer has eternal life

Even among believers, there is always the danger of alienation
(Death)

Col. 3:12-13 And so, as those who have been chosen of God,
holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness,
humility, gentleness and patience

bearing with one another, and forgiving each other,

whoever has a complaint against anyone

just as **the Lord forgave you...**
