

alone.



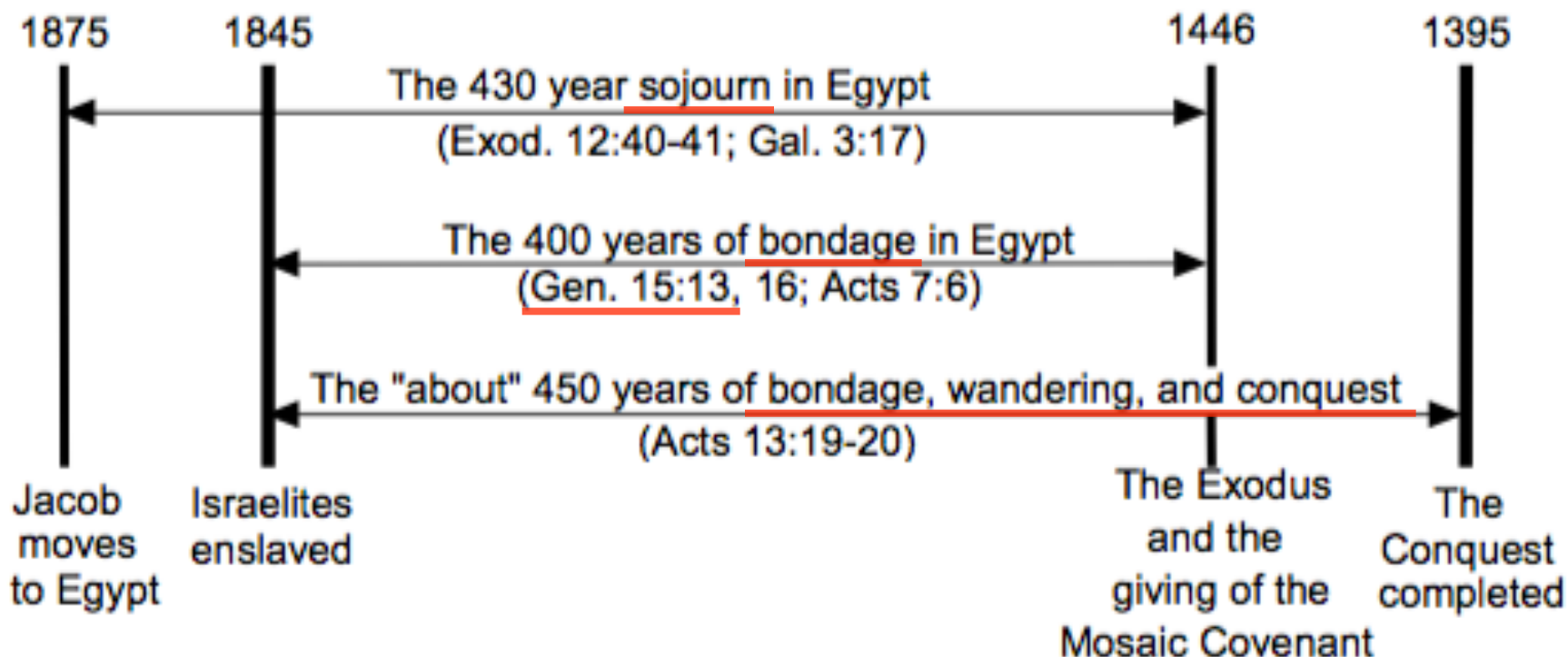

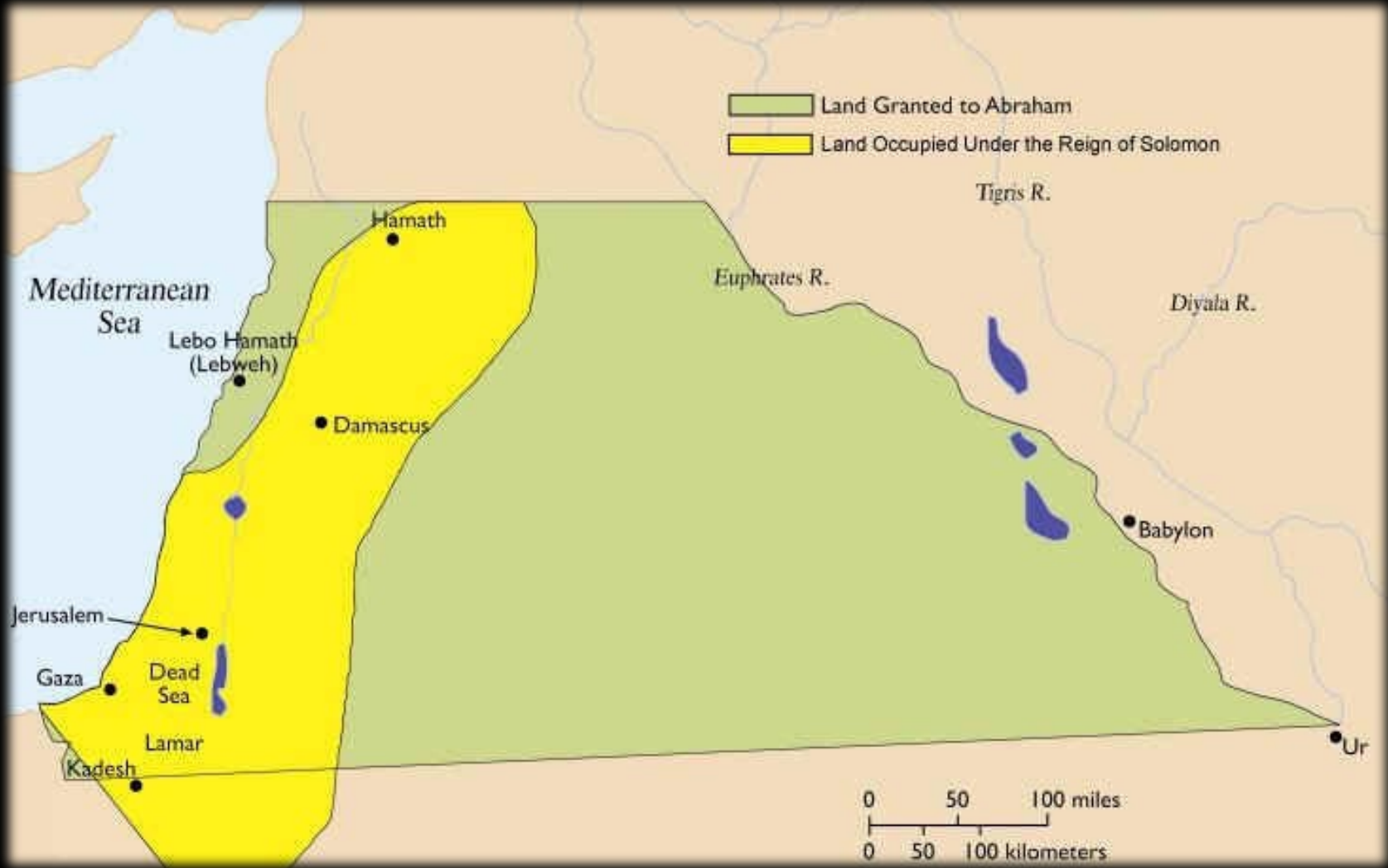

greater, **He swore by Himself**

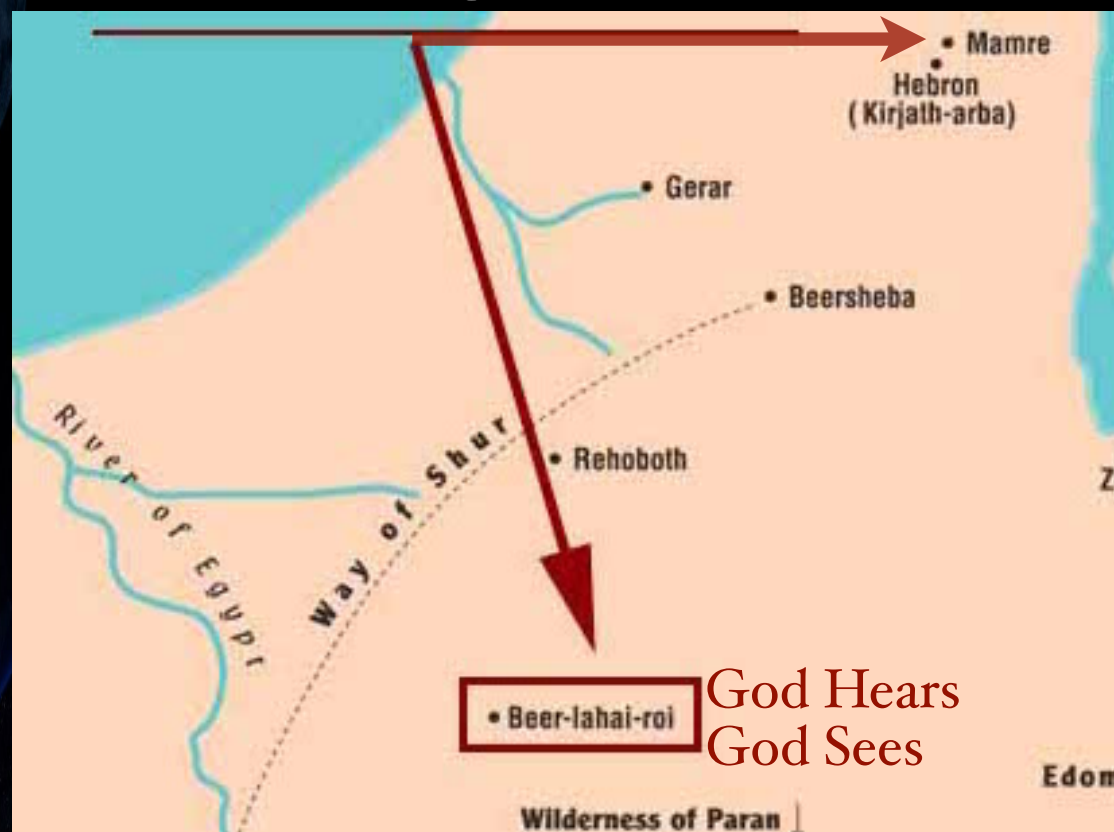
