Gen. 40:4 The captain of the guard assigned them to Joseph ...

"Do not interpretations belong to God? Tell me your dreams."

Gen 40:8 "We both had dreams ...

The Cupbearer "Your Head ... Restored"

"Your Head ... Removed" The Baker



Gen 40:14 "Remember me ... be loyal to me" Remember me to Pharaoh ..." "I am Innocent!"

The Cupbearer "Your Head ... Restored"

Gen 40:14 The cupbearer did not remember Joseph ... He *Forgot* him

So, The Cupbearer Steps Up ... Gen 41:16 "God will give you a *complete* answer, and it will not be because of *me* ..."

Two Dreams: God Telling You Twice! Seven Years of Prosperity Seven Years of Famine

Gen. 41:25 Joseph said to Pharaoh, "God has told Pharaoh ... Gen. 41:28 God has shown Pharaoh ..."

Pharaoh — You are NOT God!

Gen. 41:32 ... the matter has been firmly decided by God, and God will do it soon

> Gen. 41:33 "Pharaoh, look for a wise man and put him in charge of the land of Egypt"

> > Gen. 41:41 Pharaoh said to Joseph, "I put *you* in charge of the whole land of Egypt"

Gen. 41:42-43 Pharaoh put his signet ring on Joseph's finger He dressed him in robes of fine linen ... and put a gold chain around his neck ... He had him ride in a chariot as his second-in-command

Gen. 41:45 Pharaoh gave Joseph the name Zaphe<u>nath</u>paneah ... and a wife; Ase<u>nath</u>, daughter of Potiphe<u>ra</u>, priest of On ...
