Abraham - Isaac - Jacob

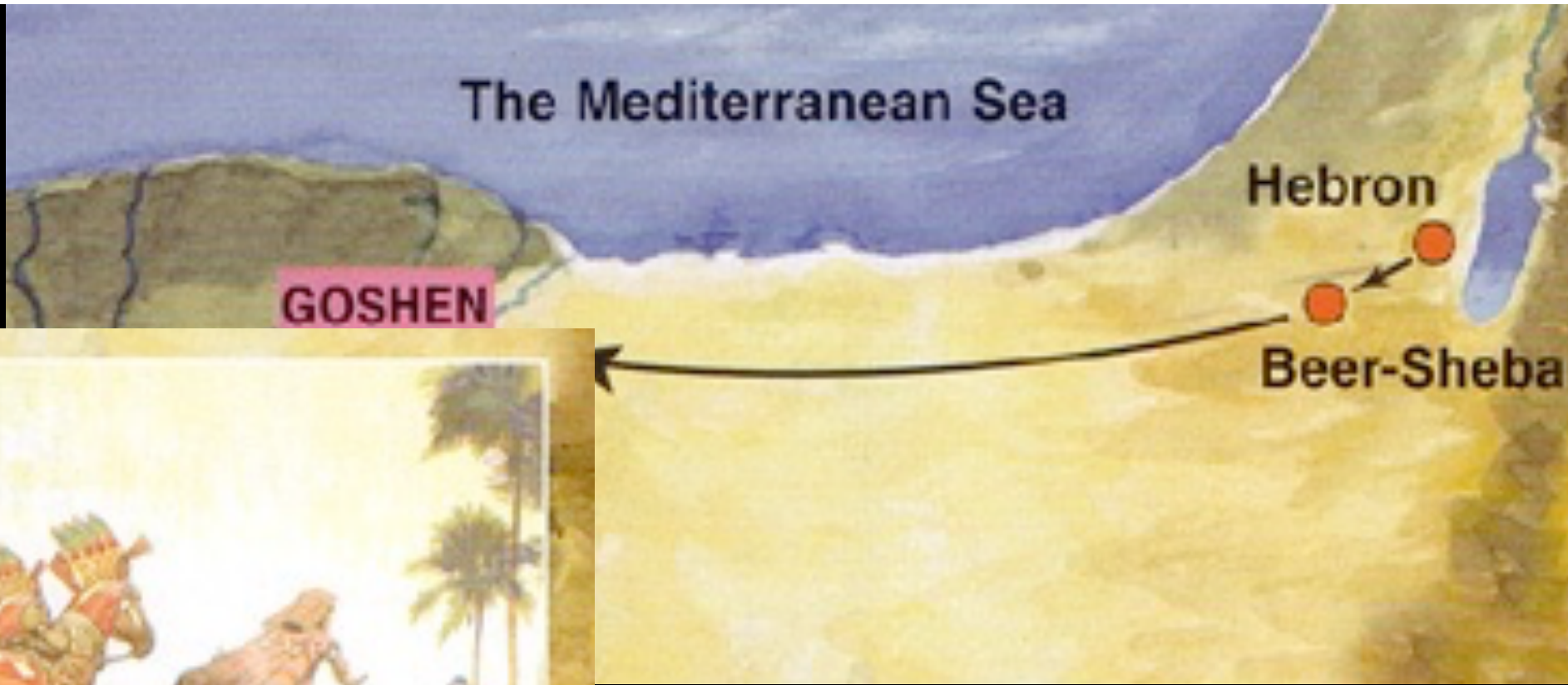
*“The Children Of Israel”*

**The Adoption Of Sons For Later Inheritance**

**48:3-5** “God Almighty appeared to me at Luz in the land of Canaan and He blessed me and said to me, ‘I am going to make you fruitful and will increase your numbers. I will make you a community of peoples, and **I will give this land as an everlasting possession** to your descendants after you.’ (Gen 15)

“Now, your two sons born to you in Egypt will be reckoned as mine ...  
Ephraim and Manasseh will be mine, just as Reuben and Simeon are mine ...

**An Inheritance Guarantee**


