A **symbol** of the highest **ruling power** in a particular area ... Rev 12:3



John 19:5 Jesus then came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. Pilate said to them, "Behold, the Man!"




"Wreath"

BEMA SEAT 1 Corinthians 3:10-15

REWARD: the payment Christ gives for good deeds and fruitful work

LOSS: punishment, loss, suffer damage ... to lose what "could have been"

If we join the elders in casting our crowns before Him, I believe He shall give them back to us so that we can join Him in *ruling 'forever and ever'.*"

"We are not well served by a theology that does not recognize the possibility of serious moral and doctrinal defection *on the part of believers.* Paul said, "You are to deliever this man to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, **so that his spirit may be saved** in the day of the Lord." (1Cor 5:5) And he said of Hymenaus and Alexander, "whom I handed over to Satan **that they may learn** not to blaspheme." (1Tim 1:20)

Some people believe that our eternal rewards are actual crowns that we will lay at Christ's feet. This has given rise to the idea that our rewards or lack of them are really quite unimportant eternally ... we cast them at the feet of Christ at a great ceremony and then everyone gets on with eternity, enjoying essentially the same privileges."
