Melchizedek 7:1-3

- 1. King of Salem
- 2. Priest of El Alyon
- 3. Righteous King
- 4. Peaceful King
- 5. No Genealogy List
- 6. Represents "A Type" of the Son of God
- 7. He Stands as a Priest for all time

Melchizedek 7:4-10

Look carefully at how Great this man is:
The GREATER always Blesses the LESSER

- 1. Abram, the Patriarch, gave him 10%
- 2. The Levitical Priests collect 10% from the People
 - a. They can do this because they descend from Abram
 - b. They have a GENEALOGY
- 3. Melchizedek has no line From Abram (No Genealogy)
 - a. He collected 10% from Abram
 - b. He Blessed Abram
 - c. **Therefore**, the Levites paid 10% through Abram
 - ... He Blessed The Levites

Melchizedek Heb 7:3

"Type" A non-verbal illustration of a future person or event. It is Predictive (*Prophetic*) *Example*: The Passover Lamb

No Genealogy Absolutely needed to establish the qualifications as a Levitical (Aaronic) Priest Made Like Made to resemble, meant "to look like" Continually For all time; forever

Melchizedek Heb 6:20


Ps 110:1 "The LORD (JahVeh) says to my Lord (Adonai) ..."


Ps 110:4 The LORD (JahVeh) swears he is also a Priest ... "after the pattern shown by Melchisedek ..."


2 Sam 6:17-18 David as a Type – A King/Priest **Jesus**: the "Son of David" is THE King/Priest




