# . ἀποστασια apostasia

"To Move From A Foundation" move from your stand looks only at the present

#### μαρτυρω marturo

"Martyr, Witness"

passive voice

NASB "gained approval" (from whom?)

KJV "obtained a good report " (? same question)


NET "received God's commendation" (the answer!)

NIV "were commended for" (WOW! bad grammar!)

#### . Faith's Certainty

Certain about Creation (a miracle wrought by God) even though we were not there to see it! it is a past event that cannot be reduplicated

Certain about Events (God controls all)
ages or "worlds" refer to people
and to timelines of history
PAST PRESENT FUTURE



### Evolution is NOT True even though I cannot prove it

Scala naturae (Aristotle 350 BC): described classified organisms in a "Ladder of Life" or "great chain of being," placing them according to their complexity of structure and function, with organisms that showed greater vitality and ability to move (evolve) to "higher organisms." ... living organisms must have what he called a "final cause"; they had been designed for a purpose.

He rejected the view that living creatures originated by chance.

#### 11:4-5 Obtaining the Testimony

God's Witness! "Well done faithful servant"

11:4 Abel "offered a better sacrifice"

He "obtained a testimony" – Righteous!

Gen 15:6 Believe God - Get a perfect standing

**στασις** Will you stay (Gen 15) or ... Walk my own way (Gen 16)??

Even though DEAD he speaks to US God is pleased with Abel

# 11:5 Enoch "taken up - changed!" He "obtained a testimony" He did NOT die (like everyone else in Gen 5) He was a contrast to the men of his age Jude 14 says he preached about coming judgment "The Lord CAME ... to execute judgment" God is pleased with Enoch

### Abe Offered Up a Blood Sacrifice He Died Jesus

**Enoch** Preached Coming Judgment He Lives

Rain? Flood? A big boat?

Enoch preached judgment ...

but the Flood is a type ...

The Ark is the means of salvation to a new world

Noah is the inheritor of the new world

God is pleased with Noah

# 11:8 Abraham "obeys and goes out" Where am I going? Faith says "The Lord knows ..." Abraham is the inheritor of a new land God is pleased with Abraham "Abram believed God ... and He declared him righteous" Gen 15:6

#### 11:9-12 Faith's Assurance

the promise gives hope

11:9-10 Abraham/Isaac/Jacob

"inheritors of the land of promise"

Aliens (Immigrants) No rights!

Looking Watching Waiting

... for a city built by God Heb 12:22

11:1 Assurance of "hoped for" things ...

#### 11:11-12 Abraham and Sarah

"life coming from apparent deadness"

Abraham and Sarah are **ONE**
