110:1 **The LORD (Oathmaker)** says to my **Lord (Messiah)**:  
"Sit at **My** right hand until **I** make **Your** enemies a footstool  
for **Your** feet."

110:4 **The LORD** has sworn (*oathed*) and will not change  
His mind, "**You are a Priest** forever according to the order  
of **Melchizedek**."

110:5 **The Lord** is at **Your** right hand -  
**He** will shatter kings in the day of His wrath -  
**He will Judge** among the nations (*not just Israel*) -  
**He** will fill the nations with corpses

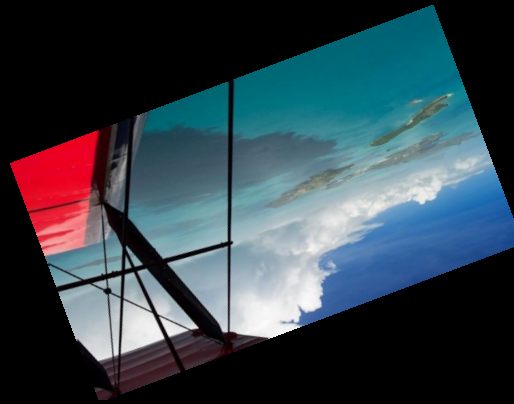
