Ch 5 David Reigns Over All Israel

- 1-5 David is Crowned King
- 6-16 David takes Jerusalem as His Capital
- 17-25 David defeats the Philistines

Ch 6 David Moves The Ark to Jerusalem

- 1-4 David goes to get the Ark
- 5-11 Uzzah dies from touching the Ark
- 12-15 The Levites carry the Ark
- 16-19 David celebrates
- 20-23 Michal's contempt for David

Ch 7 David's Covenant With The Lord

- 1-3 David's plan to build a house for the Lord
- 4-9 God says, "I didn't ask you to build a house for Me."
- 10-17 God promises "I will make you a "house" and a throne forever
- 18-29 David praises and prays with gratitude for God's promise

Purpose Clauses

2Sa 5:17 When the Philistines heard that they had anointed David king over Israel, all the Philistines went up **to seek out David...** *(there is no reason given for seeking him—is to form an alliance? Or to go to war?)*

2Sa 6:2 And David arose and went with all the people who were with him to Baale-judah, **to bring up from there the ark of God** which is called by the Name,

2Sa 6:3 They placed the ark of God on a new cart **that they might bring it** from the house of Abinadab which was on the hill;

2Sa 6:21 So David said to Michal, "It was before the LORD, who chose me above your father and above all his house, **to appoint me ruler** over the people of the LORD, over Israel; therefore I will celebrate before the LORD.

2Sa 7:8 "Now therefore, thus you shall say to My servant David, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, "I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep, **to be ruler** over My people Israel.

2Sa 7:10 "I will also appoint a place for My people Israel and will plant them, **that they may live in their own place** and not be disturbed again,

2Sa 7:23 "And what one nation on the earth is like Your people Israel, whom God went **to redeem** for Himself as a people and **to make a name** for Himself, and **to do a great thing** for You and awesome things for Your land, before Your people whom You have redeemed for Yourself from Egypt, *from nations and their gods? (Three purposes of God in rescuing Israel from Egypt)* do as You have spoken,

2Sa 7:26 **that Your name may be magnified** forever, by saying, 'The LORD of hosts is God over Israel'; and may the house of Your servant David be established before You. *(Notice how David's prayer matches God's purpose in v.23. May the purpose be realized)*

2Sa 7:29 "Now therefore, may it please You to bless the house of Your servant, **that it may continue forever** before You. *(David again prays God's purpose be realized)*
