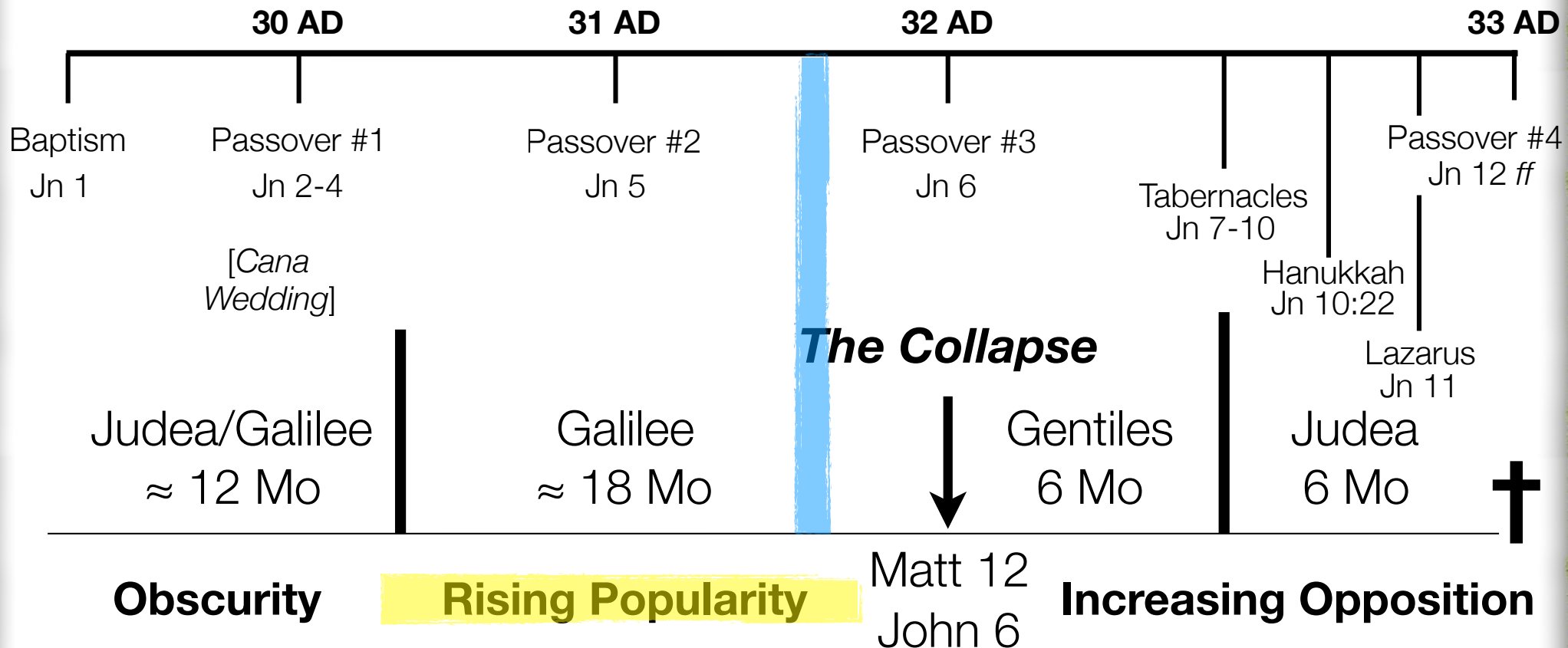

to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor (Grace),
AND the day of vengeance of our God;
*to comfort all who mourn; to grant to those who mourn in
Zion, to give them a beautiful headdress instead of ashes, the
oil of gladness instead of mourning, the garment of praise
instead of a faint spirit; that they may be called oaks of
righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He may be
glorified.*

Jer 31:31-34 Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a New Covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, not like the Covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My Covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD.

For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days: I will put My law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

... For I will forgive their iniquity,
and I will remember their sin no more.
