"Parallel Poetry"


Synonomous: restate 1st line

Antithetic: 2nd line opposite the 1st line

Synthetic: 2nd/3rd lines complete the 1st line

FOOL

- 1. Pa-TEE: The "simpleton". Young. Naive. Gullible 1:32
- 2. Ca-SEEL: Hates learning and knowledge. Stupid 1:32; 8:5
- **3. A-VEEL:** Lacks common sense. Moral insolence 1:7
- 4. Na-VAL: Disgraceful and arrogant. 30:32
- 5. Laits: The "scoffer". No correction ever possible 9:7,8

peta-eem? layts-eem? ceseel-eem?

1:23 Turn to me (repent)

I will **pour out** (*into you*) ...

My Spirit ... My Word



1:24-26 You **Refuse?**I will *laugh at you*! I will *mock you*!

you **reject** (*detest*) me, you **ignore** me, you **did not want** *to turn*



the naive (*patee*): **slides back**into death,
refusing to **turn to me**

the fool (caseel): **prosperity**destroys him,
he wants to be **stupid**



1:33 The man who listens (shema)
can relax ...
not be afraid ...
of anything!
confident security
peaceful tranquility



2:6-8 The Lord gives wisdom ..."

He is a "storehouse" of wisdom The Lord is a shield

The Lord preserves, keeps us safe
