### All The Nations Worship Messiah Jesus

- **Zec 14:16-21** ... any who are left of all the nations that fought against Jerusalem will go up every year **to worship** the King, the LORD of hosts, **and to celebrate** the Feast of Booths.
- ... whichever of the families of the earth does not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, there will be no rain on them. If the family of Egypt does not go up or enter, then no *rain will fall* on them; it will be the plague with which the LORD smites the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.
- This will be the punishment of all the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.

### **Holiness And Glory**

# Zec 14:20-21 In that day there will *be inscribed* on the bells of the horses, "HOLY TO THE LORD." And the cooking pots in the LORD'S house will be like the bowls before the altar.

Every cooking pot in Jerusalem and in Judah will be holy to the LORD of hosts; and all who sacrifice will come and take of them and boil in them. And there will no longer be a **Canaanite** in the house of the LORD of hosts in that day.

### The Messianic Sacrifices *"How Can That Be True?"*

**Heb 10:3-4** But in those *sacrifices* there is a reminder of sins year by year. For it is **impossible** for the blood of bulls and goats **to take away sins**.

**Heb 10:11-14** Every priest stands daily ministering and offering time after time the same sacrifices, <u>which can never take away sins</u>; but **He**, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, SAT DOWN AT THE RIGHT HAND OF GOD, waiting from that time onward UNTIL HIS ENEMIES BE MADE A FOOTSTOOL FOR HIS FEET. For **by one offering <u>He has</u> perfected for all time** those who are sanctified.

**Heb 10:18** Now where there is forgiveness of these things, there is no longer *any* offering for sin.

### **The Messianic Sacrifices**

- **Heb 9:9-12** ... both gifts and sacrifices are offered which **cannot make the worshiper perfect in conscience**, since they *relate* only to food and drink and various washings, regulations for the body imposed **until** a time of reformation. (*Temporary*)
- But when Christ appeared a high priest of the good things to come through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation, and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained *Eternal* redemption. (*Which does make us Perfect - in HIM*)

**Heb 9:21-23** ... he [Moses] sprinkled both the tabernacle and all the vessels of the ministry with the blood.

And according to the Law, *one may* almost *say*, all things are cleansed with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. (*Atonement*) Therefore **it was necessary** for **the copies of the things in the heavens to be cleansed with these (Is not the Millennial Temple a COPY?)**, but the heavenly things themselves (*must be cleansed*) with better sacrifices than these.

### **The Messianic Sacrifices**

#### 1Jn 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

The confession by the believer is *Efficacious* for *Cleansing*, but is unrelated to essential salvation. Confession today, like animal sacrifices in the Kingdom, is not *Salvific*, but is *Cleansing*.
