παρακλησις comfort, encouragement **Dan. 12:2** Many of those who *sleep* in the dust of the ground will *awake*, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace, everlasting contempt.

John 6:40 For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day.

1Th. 4:13 But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. 4:14 For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep.

God will bring with Jesus

2 Cor 5:8 Absent from the body ho have no HOPE!

1Cor. 15:42 So it is with the resurrection of the dead.

What is sown (like a seed) is perishable;

what is raised (from that seed) is imperishable.

43 It is sown in dishonor;

it is raised in glory.

It is sown in weakness;

it is raised in power.

**Eph. 3:6** *This mystery* is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same Body (*the Church made up of Jews and Gentiles*), and partakers of the promise **in Christ** Jesus through the gospel.

Col 1:26 ... the mystery which has been hidden from the past ages and generations, but has now been manifested to His saints, 27 to whom God willed to make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

### άρπαζω

#### to seize, plunder, snatch away

**Matt. 13:19** When anyone hears the word about the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and *snatches away* what was sown in his heart; this is the seed sown along the path.


