2 Thessalonians 1:1-12 Blessed Are The Persecuted ... Praise For Persecution



1:3-4 Gratitude—Again

1Th. 2:19 For who is our hope or joy or Crown of Exultation?

Is it not even you, in the presence of our Lord Jesus at His coming?

2Th. 1:5 This (endurance under persecution) is a plain indication of God's righteous judgment <u>so that</u> you will be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which indeed you are suffering.

Evidence for a Verdict

You ARE Worthy!

καταξιω "Exceedingly Fit, Worthy!"

Acts 14:19-22 Jews came from Antioch and Iconium, and having won over the crowds, they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, supposing him to be dead. But while the disciples stood around him, he got up and entered the city. The next day he went away with Barnabas to Derbe. After they had preached the gospel to that city and had made many disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch, strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith ... and saying, "Through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God."

"Pay Back"

- **2Th. 1:6** For after all it is just for God to **repay** with affliction those who afflict you,
- 1:7 and to give **relief** to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire,
- **1:8** dealing out **retribution** to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.
- 1:9 These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power ...

1:6 The Pay Back

Affliction/Torment/Pain

1:7 The Relief

Rest/Freedom

... when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire,

ἀποκαλυψις "Revelation, Uncover"

1:10 when He comes to be *glorified* in His saints on *That*Day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed
for our testimony to you was believed.

ένδοξα "Glorified, Honored" θαυμαζω "Amazing, Awesome!" ON <u>THAT</u> DAY!

... because you BELIEVED our Testimony

2Th. 1:8 ... dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. 2Th. 1:9 These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power ἐνδικω "Payment in Kind, Vengeance" ἀλεθρῶν "Ruin, Loss"

1:11-12 We Pray With Purpose

1:11 To this end also we pray for you always, *that* our God will count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire for goodness and the work of faith with power, 2Th. 1:12 *so that* the name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and [the] Lord Jesus Christ.

Persecution Means Blessing!

Matt. 5:10 "Blessed are those who have been persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Matt. 5:11 "Blessed are you when people insult you and persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me.

Matt. 5:12 "**Rejoice** and be glad, for **your** *Reward in Heaven* **is great** (*a Huge Pay Back*)—for in the same way, they persecuted the prophets who were before you.
