**Rev. 20:6** Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.

**Rev. 20:7** When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released...





# AFTER the Rapture—The Apostasy

**2Th. 2:1** ¶ Now we request you, brethren, with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, **2:2** that you not be quickly shaken from your composure or be disturbed either by a spirit or a message or a letter as if from us, to the effect that *the Day of the Lord has come*.

**2:3** Let no one in any way deceive you, for *it will not come* or *it has not come* unless **The Apostasy** comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed ...

2:3 How do I know the Day of The LORD hasn't come? **Because**, Number One, **The Apostasy** has not happened yet, and, Number Two, their has been no **Revelation** (*uncovering*, *revealing*) of **The Man of Sin** ...

(Paul does not "re-argue" his former premise: **Jesus comes for us FIRST!** 1 Th 1:10, 5:9)

#1 Apostasy #2 Revelation

"to go, move from your place, position"

στασια

Acts 21:21 ... and they (Jewish believers) have been told (by the Jewish Leaders) about you (Paul), that you are teaching all the Jews who are among the Gentiles to forsake (to be apostates from) Moses, telling them not to circumcise their children nor to walk according to the customs (of Rabbis).

*Heb 1:1-2* God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, *in these last days* has spoken to us in His Son,

**2Tim 3:1-5** But realize this, that **in the last days** difficult times will come. Because men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant ... ... lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power. **Avoid** (*Present Active*) **men like these.** (*Men who lived THEN!*)

**Rev 3:1** "To the angel of the church in **Sardis** write: He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars, says this: I know your deeds, that you have a name that you are alive, **but you are dead.** 

**Rev 3:17** "To the angel of the church in **Laodicea** write: Because you say, "I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing," and you do not know that **you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked ...**
