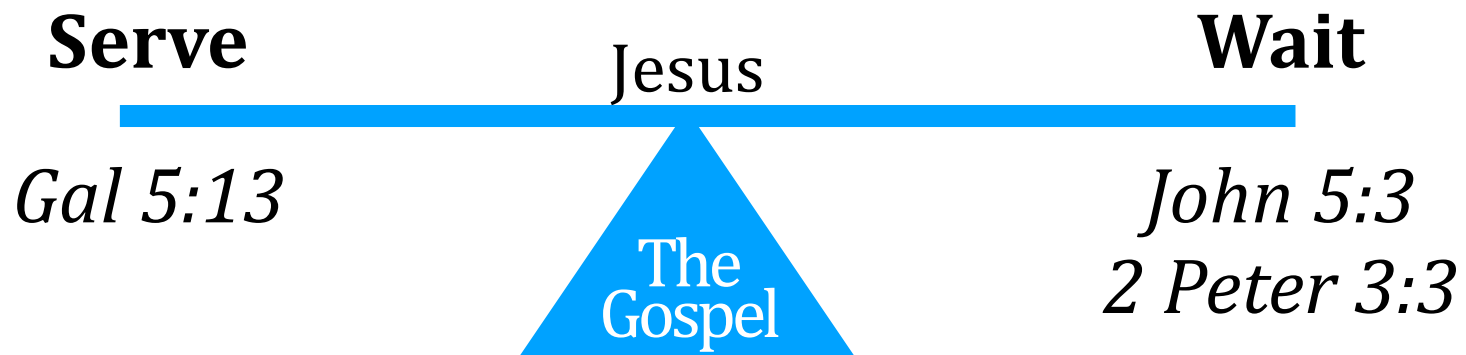


1 Thess 1:9-10



“Jesus, Who Delivers Us FROM *The Wrath To Come*”

The Wrath = The Apostasy

The Man of Sin (*Lawlessness*)

2Th. 2:1 Now we request you, brethren, with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, 2:2 that you not be quickly shaken from your composure or be disturbed either by a spirit or a message or a letter as if from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come.

2:3 Let no one in any way deceive you, for [*it will not come*] unless the apostasy comes first, and **the man of lawlessness** is revealed, **the son of destruction, 2:4** who opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, ***so that*** he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God — (*v.5 parenthetical and the sentence continues through v. 7*)

2 Th 2:1-2 Brothers, we are asking you not to be mentally shaken(*pass.*) so quickly, or be fearfully alarmed (*mid.*) by a spirit (*prophesying*) or speech or letter as if it came from us that, *quote*: “**The Day of the Lord HAS COME!**”

2 Th 2:3 Do not let anyone deceive you (*act.*) by any means or manner ... because **IF** THE Apostasy has not come first (*act.*), and the man of lawlessness has not been revealed (*pass.*), the son of destruction, the one who opposes and puts himself above every god and form of worship, and *the result is* he sets himself up in the temple of God, publicly displaying himself that “He is god”—

THEN (*the only conclusion that makes sense*)—

“The Day of the Lord HAS **NOT** COME!”
