2 Th 2:1 Brothers, we are asking you, in regard to our previous discussion about the *Coming* of our Lord Jesus Christ (**Coming** For Us)

and our gathering together *TO* Him ...

(**TO** meet Him "in the air"—Not "on the earth")

v. 2 not to be **mentally shaken** so quickly, or be **alarmed**, by a spirit prophecy or speech or letter as if it came from us that, quote: "The Day of the Lord HAS COME!"
(Perfect Tense Active Voice)

2 Th 2:3 **You** do not allow anyone to deceive you with any (active voice)

means or method: prophecy, sermon or letter as if from us ... because **IF** THE Apostasy **did not come**, as a first event, (3rd class cond.) (aorist tense active voice)

and the man of lawlessness was not revealed, as a second event, (aorist tense passive voice)

the son of destruction, the one who opposes and puts himself above every god and form of worship, and *the result is,* he sets himself up in the temple of God, publicly displaying himself that "He is god"— *THEN* (the only conclusion that makes sense)—

The Day of the Lord HAS <u>NOT</u> COME! (Previous Reference)

(Perfect Tense Active Voice)

The Coming of Jesus and The Day of The Lord

Many people throughout church history have confused the teaching of the apostles, that Christ *could* come at any moment (for believers at the Rapture), with the unbiblical idea that He *would* come soon. The first, correct view, is the doctrine of imminence, but the second, incorrect view, involves date setting.





2Th. 2:6 And you know what restrains him now, so that in his time **he** (*The Man of Lawlessness*) will be revealed.

2Th. 2:7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only **he** who now restrains **him** will continue to restrain **him** until **he** (the one who restrains) is taken out of the way.
