
2Th 2:6 And you know what restrains him now ...

Does Israel = The Church?

Are they the same thing?

Jesus, a Jew, did not think that ... Matt 16:18-19

Matt. 16:18 "I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock **I** will build My church (future tense); and the gates of Hades will not overpower it (future tense).

Matt. 16:19 "I will give (future tense) you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven."

Does Israel = The Church?

Peter, a Jew, didn't know it ... Acts 11:15-18

Acts 11:16 "And I remembered the word of the Lord, how He used to say, 'John baptized with **water**, but you will be baptized with the **Holy Spirit**.' **Acts 11:17** "Therefore if God gave to them **the same gift** as [He gave] to us also after believing in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could stand in God's way?"

Acts 11:18 When they heard this, they quieted down and glorified God, saying, "Well then, God has granted to the Gentiles also the repentance [that leads] to life."

Does Israel = The Church?

Paul, a Jew, didn't know it ... Col 1:25-26, Eph 3:3-6

Col. 1:25 Of this Church I was made a minister according to the stewardship from God bestowed on me for your benefit, so that I might fully carry out the [preaching of] the word of God,

Col. 1:26 the mystery *which has been hidden from the [past] ages and generations,* but has now been manifested to His saints ...

- **Eph. 3:3** ... by revelation there was made known to me the **mystery**, as I wrote before in brief.
- **Eph. 3:4** By referring to this, when you read you can understand my insight into the **mystery** of Christ,
- **Eph. 3:5** which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit;
- **Eph. 3:6** [to be specific], that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow **members of the body**, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel ...

Mystery *n.* not "mysterious" or unknowable, but outside the realm of natural understanding until it is revealed by Divine revelation, and is made known at a time appointed by God, and only to those who are illumined by His Spirit.

Does Israel = The Church?

John, a Jew, didn't know it ... Rev 21:12-15

Rev. 21:12 It had a great and high wall, with *twelve gates*, and at the gates twelve angels; and names [were] written on them, which are [the names] of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel.


Rev. 21:13 [There were] three gates on the east and three gates on the north and three gates on the south and three gates on the west.

Rev. 21:14 And the wall of the city had *twelve foundation stones*, and on them the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

Does Israel = The Church? NO! The Church and Israel ARE DISTINCT!

The Nation of Israel: Began at Sinai on Pentecost (*Ex 20*)

The Body of Christ: Began in Jerusalem on Pentecost (*Acts 2*)
