

- **2Th. 3:6** Now we **command** you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you keep away from every brother who leads an **unruly life (ataktos)** and not according to the tradition which you received from us.
- 3:7 For you yourselves know how you ought to follow our example, because we did not act in an *undisciplined manner (atakteo)* among you, 3:8 nor did we eat anyone's bread without paying for it, but with labor and hardship we were working night and day so that we would not be a burden to any of you, 3:9 not because we do not have the right, but in order to offer ourselves as a model for you, so that you would follow our example. (*Imitate US!*)
- 3:10 For even when we were with you, we used to give you this order: if anyone is not willing to work, then he is not to eat, either.
- 3:11 For we hear that some among you are leading an *undisciplined life (ataktos)*, doing no work at all, but acting like busybodies.
- *3:12* Now <u>such persons we **command**</u> and exhort in the Lord Jesus Christ to work in quiet fashion and eat their own bread.
- 3:13 But as for you, brethren, do not grow weary of doing (that which is) good.

ατακτος not arranged, not orderly, not consistent ataxia: a loss of full control of bodily movements ... uncoordinated muscular movement

τακτος

... proper and correct order, an orderly manner or way

17im. 5:13 ... they (young widows) also learn to be idle, as they go around from house to house; and not merely idle, but also gossips and busybodies (NOT working but VERY "busy"), talking about things not proper ...

ατακτος // Sluggard

Prov. 26:16 The **sluggard** is wiser in his own eyes Than seven men who can give a discreet answer.

Prov. 21:25-26 The desire of the sluggard puts him to death, For his hands refuse to work. All day long he is craving — While the righteous gives and does not hold back ... he works, and has no craving, he is generous, and his desire leads to a life that brings others to life!

2Th. 3:14 If anyone does not obey our instruction (our command that we get from Jesus Christ 3:6) in this letter, take special note of that person and do not associate with him, so that he will be put to shame.
3:15 And do not regard him as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.

1Cor. 15:33 Do not be deceived: "Bad company corrupts good morals (ethos)."

2Th. 3:16 Now may the Lord of peace Himself continually grant you peace in every circumstance. The Lord be with you all!

2Th. 3:17 I, Paul, write this greeting with my own hand, and this is a distinguishing mark in every letter; this is the way I write (accept NO Substitutes).

2Th. 3:18 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with all you all. (Awl Yawl)
