

2Cor. 8:1-5 We want you to know what God's grace has accomplished in the churches in Macedonia. **2** They have been severely tested by persecution, **but their JOY was so great, that they were extremely generous in their GIVING**, even though they are very poor ...

The Present Struggle 1:9-10

Faith —> Repentance —> Commitment —> Expectation. *The FULL scope of the Christian life*

1Th. 1:10 ... to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers *us* from (*out of*) the wrath to come.

1Th. 5:9 For God **has not destined** *us* **for wrath**, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, **10** who died for us, *so that* whether we are awake or asleep, we will live together with Him.

1Th. 4:17 ... we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord. 4:18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.

This is the will of God, your Sanctification

That you KNOW "learn"
That you CONTROL "your own body (imagination, will)"
IN "ongoing" holiness (sanctification)
and honor (value your body)
NOT IN lust ("I want that...") of passion

1Th. 5:16 **Rejoice** always;


1Th. 5:17 **Pray** without ceasing;
