 - Scene Like A Courtroom
 - Glimpse Into The Throne Room(?)
 - Place Of Judgment And Mercy

● 3:1 "The Accuser" Accuses

● 3:2 "The Angel Of The Lord" Defends

Job 1:6 Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them.

Job 1:7 The LORD said to Satan, “From where do you come?” Then **Satan** answered the LORD and said, “**From roaming about on the earth and walking around on it.**”

Job 1:8 The LORD said to Satan, “Have you considered My servant Job? For there is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, fearing God and turning away from evil.”

Job 1:9 Then **Satan** answered the LORD, “**Does Job fear God for nothing?**”

Rev 12:7 Then war broke out in heaven. Michael and his angels fought against the dragon, who fought back with his angels, but the dragon was defeated, and **he and his angels were not allowed to stay in heaven** any longer.

Rev 12:9 The dragon was **thrown out** - the ancient serpent, named the Devil, or **Satan**, that deceived the whole world. He was **thrown down** to earth ...

Rev 12:10 ... the one who stood before our God and **accused believers** ... has been **thrown out of heaven**.

Rev 12:12 And so be glad, you heavens, and all you that live there! But **how terrible for the earth and the sea! For the Devil has come down to you, and he is filled with rage, because *he knows that he has only a little time left.***
