

Zechariah 9–11 The King Is Revealed The <u>People</u> Are Restored The King Is Rejected


## Zechariah 9


9:9 The Humble King (Matt 26) "... *humble* and riding on a donkeyon a colt, the foal of a donkey ..."

## Zechariah 10

10:4 The Warrior King (Lu 20) "From him shall come the **cornerstone**, From him *shall come* the **tent peg**, From him *shall come* the **battle bow**, From him *shall come* **every ruler**"

THESE ARE THE CENTRAL PROPHECIES YOU WANT TO REMEMBER: RIDING INTO JERUSALEM ON THE DAY – The end point of the 69 weeks of Daniel THE MESSIAH COMING AND RULING AFTER GREAT VICTORY – The end point of the 70th week of Daniel CH 11 HAS ONE MORE!





THE GLORY OF THE NATIONS IS EXPRESSED IN THE <u>RIVERS</u>: EUPHRATES (ASSYRIA) NILE (EGYPT) JORDAN (11:1-3 PHILISTIA)

10:10-12 I WILL BRING MY PEOPLE <u>FROM</u> EGYPT AND ASSYRIA <u>INTO</u> THE LAND OF GILEAD AND LEBANON 11:1-3 <u>OPEN YOUR DOORS LEBANON</u> ...WAIL! LEBANON WAIL! BASHAN WAIL! JORDAN (Some see 11:1-3 as part of what follows in 11:4-17 - The RESULT of the rejection of the King. I don't.


I see 11:1-3 as a RESULT of the Victory of the King and the destruction similar to language of 10:10-11)

Ch 9 and 10 Prophesy Blessing and Prosperity FOR ISRAEL Ch 11 Prophesies Sin and Punishment FOR ISRAEL 11:4-14 PLAY "The Good Shepherd" 11:4-5 Evil Owners Buy From Evil Shepherds ... Who Sell Helpless Sheep 11:6 NO Pity I Will Have NO Pity On The People Gentile Kings Will Be In Charge I Will Not Deliver My People

11:4-14 PLAY "The Good Shepherd"
11:7-10 Zechariah "Plays" Messiah Shepherds An Afflicted Flock
A Pleasant Bonds (An Easy Yoke)
He Is Opposed By Other Shepherds
He Quits As The Good Shepherd



THE THREE SHEPHERDS <u>MAY REPRESENT</u> THE PRIESTS (The Temple), THE SCRIBES, THE PHARISEES (The Synagogues) – All three groups exploited the people.

11:4-14 PLAY "The Good Shepherd"
11:11-14 Messiah Rejected
They Know God Is Speaking
They Disregard His Value
Slave Wages Thrown To The Potter
The Union Is Destroyed



THIRTY SILVER COINS: The value here may be large. The point is - it is the amount paid for a dead slave.

**THE POTTER:** The poorest people who would have lived in or near the Temple seeking menial work.

Throwing the money to the potter showed a **disdain/disregard/disrespect** for the amount.

Not worthy compared to the TRUE VALUE of the shepherd.

11:15–17 PLAY "The Evil Shepherd" Shepherd With NO Kindness A "Worthless" Shepherd Defeated And Disgraced



The HB Word for FOOL is "<u>evili</u>" He is the OPPOSITE of what a good shepherd would be. The HB Word for WORTHLESS is "idol" –Empty, Void Of Power. "ARM and EYE" Strength and Intelligence. Shown to be WEAK and FOOLISH Rejection Of The TRUE Shepherd Reception Of The FALSE Shepherd The False Messiah The Pseudo-Christ "The Anti-Christ" Zechariah 9 9:9 The Humble King Zechariah 10 10:4 The Warrior King Zechariah 11 11:13 The Rejected King

**Zec 11:13** Then the LORD said to me, "Throw it to the potter, *that* magnificent price ..." So I took the thirty *pieces* of silver and threw them to the potter in the house of the LORD. (*Matt 26 and 27*)



THESE ARE THE CENTRAL PROPHECIES YOU WANT TO REMEMBER:

CH 9 RIDING INTO JERUSALEM ON THE DAY - The end point of the 69 weeks of Daniel

CH 10 THE MESSIAH COMING AND RULING AFTER GREAT VICTORY – The end point of the 70th week of Daniel

CH 11 comes between those two events: <u>THE MESSIAH SOLD FOR THE PRICE OF A</u> <u>GORED SLAVE</u>

Ch 9:2 to 11:3 is one long Oracle 11:4-17 is an Acted Object Lesson.

NB: 9:2 Begins in Judgment 11:17 Ends in Judgement. Focus on both ends is on <u>Gentiles in power</u>
