Week 26 Elisha 2 Kings 2-7

Queen Jezebel wanted to kill Elijah, after he called down fire from God against the prophets of Baal, slaughtered them, and prayed to God and ended the three year drought,. Elijah fled in fear and fell into a deep depression. He was fed and comforted by an angel and then walked forty days to Mount Sinai. Elijah complained to the Lord that he was the only faithful prophet left. God told Elijah that there were 7,000 who had not bowed to Baal. He told him to go home, anoint Hazael king of Aram, anoint Jehu king of Israel, and to anoint Elisha to succeed him as prophet.

Elijah found Elisha, put his cloak around him, and Elisha left his oxen and ran after him. Elisha left his former life and became Elijah's servant in his new life. His life reveals as a servant reveals his humility, his love for the people of Israel and his faithfulness in a lifelong ministry, a ministry that miraculously continued even after his death.

2 Kings 13:20 very simply, "Elisha died and was buried." But 13:21 says, "Some Israelites were burying a man and suddenly they saw a band of raiders, so they threw the man's body into Elisha's tomb. When the body touched Elisha's bones, the man came to life and stood up on his feet."
