

Mar 6:29 When John's disciples heard of his murder, they came and took his body and laid it in a tomb.


Matt 14:13 Now when Jesus heard about John's death, he withdrew from Capernaum in a boat to a desolate place by himself...

The Third Passover: The Collapse

Mar 6:30 The apostles returned to Jesus and told him all that they had done and taught. *31* And he said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a desolate place and rest a while." For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat.

Matt 14:13 But when the crowds heard it, they followed him on foot from the towns. **14** When he went ashore he saw a great crowd, and he had <u>compassion</u> on them and healed their sick.

Mar 6:34 He had compassion because they were like sheep without a shepherd. And he began to teach them many things.



Matt 14:15 Now when it was evening, the disciples came to shim and said, "This is a desolate place, and the day is now over; send the crowds away to go into the villages and buy food for themselves."


Deut 18:15 "The LORD your God will raise up for you a

The Third Passover: The Collapse

Mar 6:45 Immediately he made his disciples get into the boat and go before him to the other side, to Bethsaida, while he dismissed the crowd. 46 And after he had taken leave of them, he went up on the mountain to pray.

Matt 14:28 Peter responded to the familiar voice, "Lord, if it's you, . . . tell me to come to you on the water"

Matt 14:30 "Lord, save me!"



- 31 Jesus immediately reached out his hand and took hold of him, saying to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?
- **32** And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased.
- **33** And those in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

Mar 6:52 ... they did not understand about the loaves, but their hearts were hardened

The Third Passover: The Collapse

Capernaum

Mar 6:53 ... they came to land at *Gennesaret* and moored to the shore. *54* And when they got out of the boat, the people immediately recognized him *55* and ran about the whole region and began to bring the sick people on their beds to wherever they heard he was.
