




Journey to Bethany Final Appeal

1. Jesus leaves Jerusalem The Jews along with supporters in the crowd threaten stoning at the Feast of Hanukkah

2. Jesus goes where John began his ministry

(Jn 10:42)

Jesus travels up to Aenon (Jn 3:23), an area within the borders of The Decapolis

3. Jesus travels into Peraea

This is an area governed by Herod Antipas. The Pharisees say Antipas is going to arrest Him

4. Jesus goes to Bethany to raise Lazarus

Christians should be humbled before the new pagan pluralistic situation. The Church did not lose its position of privilege simply because of evil enemies of the faith. We lost our position as part of God's judgment on our pride, our hypocrisy, our love of power, our prejudice, our bigotry and failure to hold onto the truth. Our first response should be repentance. We should be very understanding toward people who have failed to believe in Christ because of the weakness of our testimony.
