- 14 Lambs killed before sundown. (Jesus Arrested Crucified Dies) Judean Passover Meal eaten
- 15 First day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread. (Jesus in the Tomb)
- 16 High Priest waves the Barley Sheaf at Sunrise.Looks to Wheat harvest in 50 days—Pentecost.

(Jesus Rising from the Tomb as the Barley is waved)
The Church is born 50 days later—Pentecost

The Order of Events Thursday Nisan 14 Galilean Calendar Nisan 13 Judean Calendar

- 1. Peter and John obtain the lamb, sacrifice it and roast it over a spit.
- 2. They prepare the rest of the meal, making sort of a lamb stew, unleavened bread, wine, bitter herbs, and charoset..
- 3. Jesus and the others come from Bethany and meet at the Upper Room. Jesus has kept the location hidden from Judas.
- 4. Jesus begins the meal. While they are eating they disciples argue about who will be the greatest in the Kingdom.
- 5. As they are arguing, Jesus gets up, washes the disciples feet.
- 6. After washing their feet, Jesus says one of them will betray Him.
- 7. Jesus tells John privately that it is Judas, gives Judas "the sop", and tells him to go.
- 8. Judas leaves. Only John and Jesus know what he is going to do.
- 9. Jesus tells them He is going away and they cannot follow.
- 10. Jesus tells Peter that he will deny Him three times before daybreak.
- 11. Jesus institutes the New Covenant Memorial to be done in His memory.

Sundown: 6 pm to midnight both calendars: Nisan 14

- 12. They all leave and go to the Mount of Olives.
- 13. Jesus grieves in the Garden of Gethsemane.
- 14. Jesus is arrested in the Garden, identified by Judas with a kiss.
